Burghley was built between 1555 and 1587 by Lord Burghley, Lord High Treasurer to Queen Elizabeth I, and is the largest and grandest house of the Elizabethan Age. The House has been beautifully restored and refurbished in recent years and is a magnificent and elegant setting for private functions. A number of rooms are available, each with its own distinctive style and Burghley can host events as

diverse as weddings, seminars, conferences and banquets. The House has also been used as a film location on many occasions, most recently it appeared as Rosings in *Pride and Prejudice* and Castel Gandolfo in the *Da Vinci Code*.

All this, together with exceptional catering and attentive, dedicated staff has made Burghley one of the most sought after venues in the country.

The Great Hall

Used as a banqueting hall in Elizabethan days and during the 19th century, today it fulfils this purpose as well as it ever did. The Great Hall provides a dignified and historic setting for up to 110 people for dinner or 160 for a drinks reception. As the setting for your event the Great Hall will add an unrivalled grandeur to your day with its double hammer beam roof, minstrels' gallery and handsome Tudor fireplace.



The Orangery

Designed by Capability Brown in the 18th century to provide space for the family's collection of rare plants, the south facing Orangery is flooded with natural light during the day and becomes an intimate, gracious venue for an evening reception. The adjacent Loggia, which opens onto the attractive rose garden, provides space for dancing. The Orangery can seat up to 80 people or 140 for a drinks reception.

Breathtaking gardens

The gardens at Burghley have changed a great deal since Lord Burghley built the House. The 9th Earl commissioned Capability Brown to landscape the Park in the 18th century and the resultant rolling green hills and serpentine lake provide a beautiful setting for Brown's banqueting house. Situated in the private gardens, it provides an atmospheric setting for civil ceremonies and drinks receptions.

Seminars and Meetings

Burghley is ideally situated, in a unique setting, for the event of your choice.
