



## Burghley – Easter Crafts From Home

We may not be able to welcome you back to the Sculpture Garden Classroom for our seasonal workshops just yet, but why not have a go at creating your own Easter Crafts from home?



Here is how to make your...  
**EASTER LAMB**



1. Take a piece of A4 card and cut it in half. If you haven't got card a cereal packet turned inside out will do.
2. Take a separate piece of black card and draw out a face shape with two ears, it needs to be nearly half the size of your lamb, (like the example).
3. Cut it out and draw or stick on two eyes.
4. Stick the head to the top part of your card in the middle.
5. Next draw the two arms and cut them out then set aside.
6. Take a piece of card about the same length but 3cms wide.
7. Draw two wavy lines along the top and bottom edge and cut out.
8. Stick this card along the top edge of your card just above the lamb's eyes.
9. Then gently roll your card up to make a cylinder shape and stick together at the back with sellotape.
10. Finally take the two arms and stick them on at the sides of your lamb.
11. Well done! You've finished your Easter lamb!
