

Burghley - Easter Crafts From Home

We may not be able to welcome you back to the Sculpture Garden Classroom for our seasonal workshops just yet, but why not have a go at creating your own Easter Crafts from home?





Here is how to make your... **EASTER LAMB**



- 1. Take a piece of A4 card and cut it in half. If you haven't got card a cereal packet turned inside out will do.
- 2. Take a separate piece of black card and draw out a face shape with two ears, it needs to be nearly half the size of your lamb, (like the example).
- 3. Cut it out and draw or stick on two eyes.
- 4. Stick the head to the top part of your card in the middle.
- 5. Next draw the two arms and cut them out then set aside.
- 6. Take a piece of card about the same length but 3cms wide.
- 7. Draw two wavy lines along the top and bottom edge and cut out.
- 8. Stick this card along the top edge of your card just above the lamb's eyes.
- 9. Then gently roll your card up to make a cylinder shape and stick together at the back with sellotape.
- 10. Finally take the two arms and stick them on at the sides of your lamb.
- 11. Well done! You've finished your Easter lamb!
